Entry and short stay (not exceeding three months).

If you intend to come to the Netherlands as a tourist, to visit relatives or on business, you must hold a valid passport containing a visa if necessary issued by a representative of one of the Benelux countries abroad. ¹⁾ ²⁾ Some other document valid for foreign travel (for example, an identity card) which is officially accepted may serve instead of a passport.

In addition, you may be asked to prove that you have adequate means of self-support for the duration of your proposed stay in the Netherlands or in the other two Benelux countries and that the cost of your return journey is covered (a return ticket would be accepted as proof).

If you are not staying in the Netherlands, you must report to the Aliens Department in the area of your intended stay. If you have come to the Netherlands to accept employment, you must report to the Aliens Department. If your presence in the Netherlands is of a nature which is detrimental to the national security, for reasons of public order or for other reasons, you will not be admitted.

Stay exceeding three months.

If you intend to stay in the Netherlands for a longer period (for example, for a temporary residence or for a permanent residence), you must report to the Aliens Department in the area of your intended stay. Residence permits.

Residence permits are issued for a maximum period of one year. They may be renewed. They may be prosecuted for or

- 1) Maximum duration of the visa.
- 2) No visa is required.
- 3) For children under 16 years of age, apply to the Aliens Department.
- 4) Belgian and Luxembourg nationals.
- 5) Nationals of E.E.C. countries.
- 6) A work permit is not required.

**WENKEN VOOR VREEMDELINGEN MET HET OOG
